

Will you tape this man?

A ROMANCE behind the Iron Curtain between a record smuggler and a Russian punk star is to blossom into marriage early next year—with the approval of the Soviet authorities.

For a couple of years American-born Joanna Field, 26, has been smuggling British pop records into the Soviet Union and returning with tapes of Russian bands. Her compilation album of unofficial Russian groups like Aquarium and Kino was released here last week.

During the eight short trips Joanna has made to Leningrad since 1984, she has fallen in love with Yuri Kasparyan, peroxide blond bass player with Kino.

"We've arranged to have a proper State affair with the ceremony at the People's Wedding Palace in Leningrad," she says. "I've been detained by the Soviet authorities on a number of occasions in the past, but now that they realise my motives are entirely honorable I don't expect problems in the future."

Ms Field and Yuri don't expect to see much of each other in the near future. He will stay in Leningrad while she travels back and forth with more tapes.
